WAT Totals!

We are so happy to report a record-breaking total for walkathon 2007! Our students raised a total of \$53,298.41! Nearly \$36,700 will go into our Family Financial Aid Fund for next year. A few of our staff members have been here for all 23 walkathons, and I understand the first year the walkathon raised \$10,500. How far we have come!

The additional \$16,598.91 will go to the class treasuries. The teachers have received their new totals. The fifth grade raised their class treasury total by over \$3760! This will help them pay for Rancho El Chorro later this year! Every grade, from first to eighth, raised their class treasuries total to between \$1041 and \$2585.

This is a new record for Walkathon, and we are so proud of our walkers, our parent volunteers, our teachers and each and every participant!

Again, special thanks to Mary Perry, who saw the process through from beginning to last penny end.
